*Galatians 2:15-3:5*

## Justified by faith

*Galatians 2:15-19*

“Justified” is to be declared righteous or innocent.

Faith is the means of justification; grace is the source.

The only alternative to justification by faith is by works.

Paul isn't opposed to good works, just good works for the wrong motive.

We can be justified only by Jesus paying off your guilt.

## Sanctified by faith

*Galatians 2:20-21*

Crucified with Christ = You have died to your sinful nature.

Your life is now motivated by Jesus' Spirit in you.

You are sanctified (made holy) the same way you are justified:  
by grace through faith.

## Faith is our answer from first to last

*Galatians 3:1-5*

If you can't save yourself from sin, how do you think you can keep yourself from sin?

*Romans 1:17*

You can't solve your biggest problem because it is you.
